Dear Parent or Student,

On Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2010, Sheffield High School is excited to be hosting the BBC Radio 4's 'Any Questions?', which will be broadcast live.

As you may know, the first 'Any Questions?' was over 50 years ago. Each week, it visits a different community with a panel of four speakers and answers questions from an audience. The questions are relevant to the interests of the particular panel members and relate to the events of that week – they could concern local interest (but obviously the programme is broadcast nationally), and they can be light-hearted as well as serious. Questions are submitted on the evening itself and can be written on a form attached to your ticket, or on paper. We do not yet know who the panel members will be and details will be posted on the School's website nearer the time, but Jonathan Dimbleby will be Chairman.

If you would like a ticket to be a member of the audience please return the attached reply slip below, or apply in writing to Mr Mozley, Deputy Head, at School. Alternatively you can request a ticket by emailing enquiries@she.gdst.net.

Please note

- You will need to apply for your own ticket (we cannot issue multiples to one applicant). Tickets are free. The minimum age for audience members is 14. No-one can be admitted without a ticket.
- You will need to arrive at School between 6.45 and 7.15 pm. Please remember to allow time for parking – we shall be very limited on what we can provide on the school grounds.
- Questions are submitted during this period and about 10 will be chosen by the production team, each to be asked by the audience member who submitted it. Questions cannot be asked by proxy.
- The audience must be seated by 7.15, and we shall be filling up the seats from the front rather than allocating seat numbers in advance. The Audience will be welcomed by a senior member of the BBC staff at 7.30 pm, and the programme goes on air live at 8.02 pm.

As you will appreciate, as this event is in the second week of the academic year, we have to begin the process of organization now. We are looking forward to hosting this event tremendously, and are sure we shall have a wide and varied audience.
